


# POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION SUPPORTS




## YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR POST-SECONDARY (COLLEGE AND/OR VOCATIONAL) FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IF:

- You exited OKDHS or tribal custody, from an out-of-home placement, on or after your 16th birthday
- You were in the custody of another state on or after your 16th birthday

 To determine eligibility, contact the OKSA Helpline or complete the ETV application located on our website.

## TYPES OF ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE:

- **Oklahoma Tuition Waiver:** Were you in OKDHS custody for 9 months or more between ages of 16 and 18?
- **Pell Grant:** Were you in foster care after age 13? Answer this question correctly on the FAFSA and contact OKSA for a verification letter to provide to the financial aid office.
- **Oklahoma's Promise:** Application needs to be made between 8th and 11th grade.  
*\*Specific program requirements apply.*
- **Education & Training Voucher:** Oklahoma Human Services non-competitive scholarship that awards up to \$5,000 per academic school year.
- **Oklahoma Youth with Promise Scholarship:** Competitive scholarship offered by Oklahoma City Community Foundation with awards starting at \$6,000 per academic year for freshman.
- **Other scholarship and grant opportunities:** Your Education Specialist will assist you in identifying other grant/scholarship opportunities.

 Most financial aid awards listed can be used at 2- or 4-year public colleges, universities, or technical schools. Some awards may only apply to Oklahoma schools. Contact OKSA to get started on your education pathway.
