- Complete Hope for Tomorrow Youth Assessment

AGE 16

- Complete Hope for Tomorrow
 Youth Assessment
- Confirm possession of youth's original or certified copy of birth certificate and Social Security cards
- Assist youth with obtaining state ID, permit or driver's license
- Discuss Teen Conference attendance with youth

AGE 17

- Complete Hope for Tomorrow Youth Assessment
- Initiate transition planning meetings**
- Confirm possession of youth's original or certified copy of birth certificate and Social Security card and photo ID
- Discuss Teen Conference attendance with youth
